PROJECT GOVIND LEELA CONCLUSION

INTRODUCTION OF PROJECT GOVIND LEELA

Pyare Foundation established five mini dispensaries and female care units in five remote villages in Uttarakhand for the health issues in those remote villages. Pyare foundation has upgraded in promoting good health in a few areas. Some common illnesses, symptoms, and diseases are either unvoiced are suggested to build tolerance in unprivileged areas. This happens due to a lack of education, financial independence, inexperienced workforce. Women and children are more vulnerable to such situations. Therefore Pyare Foundation took the initiative to promote good health among women and other individuals.

OUR WORKING MODEL

Our model is straightforward, first the team visits the village from Delhi. They meet the prominent personalities of the place and make aware the villagers about the organisation and objectives. The vision of the trust is shared through functional and strategical structure prepared by the core team members. The project of Govind Leela and it's benefits and advantages are revealed among people. The head of the town, the Pradhan briefs the organisation about their facility. The papers are formed and an agreement is given shape to be accorded recognition through village committee in **Panchayat Ghar**. The Pharmacist is chosen from the village and adjoining places and assigned the job of looking after the Mini Dispensary. The medicines, supplements, syrups and other ointments are sent from Delhi to Dispensary. The records and paper work are maintained for the proper running of the dispensary. The Pharmacist takes care of the dispensary and maintains statistics of the patients, the list of medicines and funds. The collected funds are sent back to the Delhi office, and hence the salaries are issued to the pharmacists. The project head looks over the entire project and takes the report from all the pharmacists and Ashas. The project head then must report to the president and the other core team members. Now we come on the working of the dispensary. We have put some minimal fees to avail the





services of the dispensaries. The price is INR 20 for each person, and they can get medicines for ten days by using the same slip, but the distribution of the medication is according to the patient's requirement. This is maintained by the pharmacist.

1. Village Hudu

Hudu gram sabha villages are Hudu and Karndhar, where approximately 65 families are staying, totaling about 350 members. The distance from Delhi to Ukhimath is around 427.2 km. The distance from Ukhimath to Hudu is 12 km; hence the total distance from Delhi to Hudu or vice versa becomes 439.2 km. Therefore, Pyare Foundation is giving care and medical support to 350 members of the Hudu Gram Sabha.

The process from inception of roots till the inauguration of the dispensary consists of many steps such as visits, surveys, meetings in the village, permission from DM, CMO, village Thana, Mandir Samiti, and appointment of pharmacists and allotment of medicines and necessary medical health equipment. The entire process takes approximately six days, and the team Pyare Foundation visits these villages for six days to complete the process. Pradhan Anil lal, Asha, Rekha Rawat, Ashish a villager and pharmacist Arjun singh were responsible persons to take care the unit.

Hudu connects these villages: Usada (80 families, 320 members), Kanda (35 families, 140 members), Daida (45 families, 180 members), Semar (35 families, 140 members), and Bringali (30 families, 120 members). Hence, the total beneficiary families are 290 and 1250 members.

2. Village Gadgu

The foundation established its second dispensary at Gadgu Village, District Rudraprayag, Uttarakhand, on 22 November 2016. The distance from Delhi to Ukhimath is 427.2 km. and from Ukhimath to gadgu the Distance is 13 km. There are about 110 – 120 families (around 600 members) in Gadgu. The village is also one of the remote areas of Uttarakhand where residents used to travel very long distances for medical treatment by spending a lot of money and effort. In many cases, when the environment is unfavorable, the patients have to lose their life due to the unavailability of transportation facilities. Keeping all these issues, the foundation created a team of six members and a pharmacist responsible for the maintenance and work of the dispensary on the village level. The foundation regularly monitors the dispensaries' work and provide necessary support, guidance, and medicines. Village Pradhan Mrs. Sarita Devi, Asha Mrs. Geeta Devi, Pharmacist Mr. Sudeep singh were the responsible persons to take care of the dispensary.

Gadgu connects these villages: Gair (100 families, 480 members), Giriya (80 families, 400 members), Mansoona (250 families, 1000 members), Burua (50 families, 220 members). Hence, the total beneficiary families are 590 and 2700 members.

3. Village Gondar

The foundation established its third dispensary at Gondar Village, District Rudraprayag, Uttarakhand, on 17 May 2017. No adjacent village are near Gondar. It's the last village There are about 40 – 50 families (around 160 – 200 members) in Gondar. The village is also one of the remote areas of Uttarakhand where residents used to travel very long distances for medical treatment by spending a lot of money and effort. The distance from Delhi to Ukhimath is 427.2 km. and from Ukhimath to gondar the Distance is 21 km and 6 km by foot.

Pradhan Mr. virender singh, pharmacis t Ms. Rajni panwar, Mr.Shiv singh negi were the responsible persons to take care of the unit.

4. Village Thapli

The team established a fourth dispensary in the Thapli village, district Chamoli on 12 January 2018. The distance from Delhi to karnprayag is 436.6 km. and from karnprayag to Thapli the Distance is 13.1 km. There are about 20 families (around 80 members) in Thapli. Mr. Suman Dimri inaugurated the dispensary in the presence of villagers, and written documents were exchanged. Record slips were gathered, and medicines were distributed in large quantities.

Village Pradhan Shri Suman Dimri, Smt Anita, Asha, Vinod thapliyal and Birender thapliyal are the resposible persons to take care of the unit Thapli connects these villages: Siri (45 families, 180 members), Sirpa (25 families, 100 members), Salyana (25 families, 100 members), Kulsaun (30 families, 120 members), Bagoli (50 families, 200 members), Bangaon (40 families, 160 members), Khankar (15 families, 60 members), Koti (50 families, 200 members), and Erwadi (50 families, 200 members). Hence, the total beneficiary families are 350 and 1400 members.

5. Village Ratura

On 24 December 2018, Pyare Foundation, under its Health and hygiene project banner, Govind Leela, established its fifth (5th) mini dispensary and female health care unit at Ratura Village in Uttarakhand. Ratura village comprised of about 125 families (around 500 members) as per the 2011 census but now it has around 65 families (around 260 members) as per the latest data. Out of 65 families, around 40 families (160 members) are from harijan community.

CONCLUSION

We are now concluding the phase 1 of project Govind Leela to restyle the project in a new way with few modern techniques and deliverables. The tools, ideas, team etc. will be improvised in the next phase.

The results of the phase 1 are described as below

The project Govind Leela is concluded with the completion of phase 1 till 30 March 2022. We get following results out of this project from 2016 to 2022

- 1. 5 mini dispensaries and 5 female care units were established
- 2. More than 1400 families and 6000 people were benefited
- 3. Basic health equipment and medicines were provided
- 4. Health camps in various villages
- 5. Special care for females

NOTE: The phase 2 of Govind Leela project is yet to start in 2022.






Orientation Session with UPES University Dehradun
