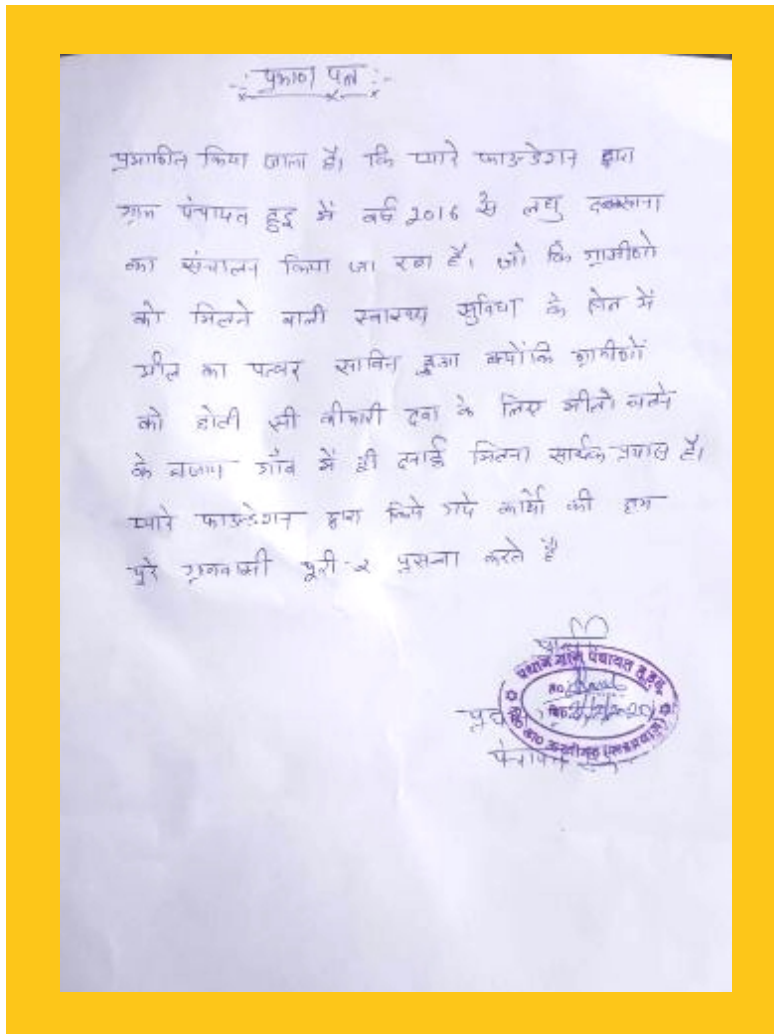


PMJAK Inaugural, Ukhimath, Uttarakhand

She suggested the idea in 1910 at an International Conference of Working Women in Copenhagen. There were 100 women there, from 17 countries, and they agreed on her suggestion unanimously. On the occasion of International Women's Day which is celebrated on 8th March globally, our president Dr. Anjali Thapliyal Kaul was honoured with Uttarakhand Matr Gaurav Samman, 2020 by Jeevan Nirman Education Society at Jacaqsveen national school, Guptakashi in Uttarakhand. According to the World Health Organization, a person aged 10–19 years is considered as an adolescent.
