MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMME

26th June - 26th August 2020



Medical science has defined the well-being of person not only in terms of physical health but also in terms of mental health. The urban population is slightly aware about these issues but the rural population has still some pre-notions attached to the word "mental" which definitely needs to be changed. The mental well -being of a person not only enhances one's performance in job or academics but also contributes to the overall happiness of the individual. Considering the fact that Mental illnesses affects 19% of the adult population, 46% of teenagers, and 13% of children each year, Pyare foundation initiated to help people suffering from depression and other mental health related issues. The foundation formed a panel of well qualified doctors to address and solve mental health related issues of the people. The program provides free consultation and advice from doctors with expertise in the field of mental health through a phone or a video call.

TELEMEDICINE PROGRAM

24th July - 24th September, 2020

The program commenced on 24th July 2020 and successfully continued till September 2020. The aim of the program was to introduce ways and means to attain good health, positive attitude, family welfare and life betterment. The program was equally sensitive towards the outbreak of the corona virus pandemic and the panic that emerged inside the country due to the rapidly increasing cases and deaths. The telemedicine program

offered counselling and advice to people facing distress and disenchantment through professional doctors with an expertise in their respective fields. The health experts associated within the initiative provided help and guidance to people seeking help to overcome ailments, infirmities, diseases, phobias, fear and weaknesses. A multidimensional approach of wellness was being employed which focused on physical, emotional, spiritual, intellectual, environmental and social well-being of a person. This initiative would have been impossible without the valuable contribution of the professional team of the doctors. The telemedicine program consisted of Dr. Sushil Kumar Arora (B.A.M.S.), Dr. Sonal



Rohtagi (Obs/Gynecologist, MBBS and MD), Dr. Tanushree Gahlot (MBBS), Dr. Sneh Pratap Singh (Homeopathic physician, D.H.M.S, Dip NIH Kolkata), Dr. Rajnish Bhardwaj (B.H.M.S), Dr. Vedprakash Maurya and Mrs. Sushma Thapliyal (clinical psychologists), Dr. Meenakshi Arjun (Naturopathy DNYS) and Dr. Sudhir Bagga (MD, MBBS). The range of doctors which were a part of the initiative enabled Pyare Foundation to aid a diverse group of people. People were given medical advice and guidance directly from the panel of well-experienced doctors via video conferencing, phone call or messaging. The program also employed interns for a better coordination and for working on health blogs to produce content concerning and addressing health issues.


