Mission


Pyare foundation is true to its cause of wellness and happiness in the light of healthy state of mind, healthy growth, higher development and peaceful steadiness.

Purpose


1. To guide the children about the value of life.


AUDIT REPORT OF M/S. PYARE FOUNDATION
