This was a good sign as they never had attempted to write.

3. Taught about the daily life work and hygiene as per their own circumstances.

1. The children started speaking in English.
2. They started behaving properly and a big reduction in their abusive language.
3. Came in washed clean clothes with properly combed hair.
4. Eager to learn many new creative activities.
5. Their body gestures shows some form of dignity in humility.



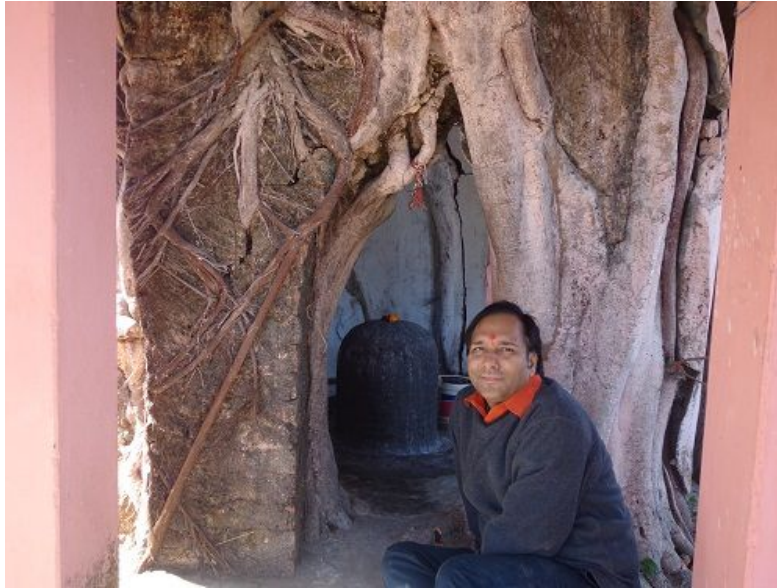
## 2. I.Q test by registered clinical psychologist Mr Gaurav Thapliyal
